Registration Information: We encourage everyone to participate in our programs, activities and events. It is recommended that you register yourself or your child for activities as soon as possible, due to the fact that some of our classes have limited space and will fill up rapidly. **Remember registration forms and/or release waivers must be submitted before participating in any program or event.** The Recreation Department has the right to cancel a program if enrollment is insufficient. They also have the right to move the location, or cancel a class if there is a building conflict.

Refund Policy: We do **not** offer refunds unless a program is cancelled due to low enrollment. We can, however, offer credit which can be used toward other recreation programs or park memberships.

Holidays and Snow Days: The Recreation Department follows the Town Calendar. When town offices are closed, there will be NO Recreation Programs. This includes inclement weather. There are NO recreation programs on Federal or state holidays.

Facility Use Information: If you are an individual or organization looking to use our facilities, you must submit a facility use application to the Recreation Department. These forms are available online or in the recreation office. Forms must be submitted by the last Friday of each month for approval for future use.

TOWN OF PAWLING SUMMER CAMP 2016 RE-CAP

While Summer 2016 brought the town of Pawling everything from heat waves to monstrous thunderstorms, one thing that remained constant was the positive atmosphere surrounding the Town of Pawling Summer Camp. This summer, campers and counselors from the area came together to experience one of the most exciting summers yet.

The makeup of our camp is different from other camps in the area because it holds a strong sense of community. Counselors at the camp were once our campers. When we started ten years ago, our current Counselors in Training (CITs) were entering the camp for the first time as Kindergarteners. The children who come through the camp program tend to remain a part of the camp once they enter high school because of the positive impact it has had on each of them. They then share that positivity with campers through their roles as CITs, counselors, and directors.



Around the camp, counselors and directors worked together to create schedules and activities that would add excitement to the camp experience. Campers of all ages participated in unique events such as buoy swims, Luau parties, scavenger hunts, LARP day, taco fiestas, and Quidditch tournaments.

This year we wanted to highlight the positivity that was being spread throughout the camp. Each week we recognized a counselor whose work made the camp a better place with our new "You Make a Difference" award. Each counselor's goal is to make camp as much fun as possible for campers. From speaking to parents, campers, and staff, it has been easy to tell that their goal was met and that each of them had made a difference at the camp.


